Maintenance	Fire Chief to get estimate for new flagpole for hall. Discussed signs for fire dept/hall. Received 2 bids. Signs tabled until next meeting. Fire Chief will get more quotes on asphalt for fire dept and for sealing parking lot. Sprinkler system at hall has been updated. Bid was for \$6,190, saved us \$700, but will sell us \$700 of much needed lime. Discussed window for Treasurer's office. Chief to get quote for thick glass instead of bulletproof.

Trucks	Good working order. New brakes on engine by Nelson Service.
Station	Did CPR Training. Bought batteries for pagers.
Cemetery/Parks/Liquor	Discussion on getting boulders for parking lot in cemetery. Will revisit this during parks visit. Discussion on gazebo for cemetery. Chief will get more quotes. In middle of cleanup. Flags are in and water turned on at cemetery. Will mow next week.
Short Term Rentals	All inspections are current.
Sewer Report	Kuyers: Construction is scheduled to restart. Contract 1: Adding 1 grinder pumpstation. Once completed, should be close to ready for final walkthrough. Contract 2: Adding generator pads to stations to be worked on this year. Construction on lift stations scheduled to restart mid-July. Their hope is that by the end of the year, should only have 1 major lift station to go. Contract 3: 9 grinder pumpstations to be started this month. Will be on North end of Lake in Selma Twp. This should also start in the next couple weeks. Funding continues to be the major concern. Rep. Fox submitted an appropriations request for \$5 million. Rep. Moolenaar is also requesting \$5 million (would require a matching grant of 25%). If we can get these into place, estimating \$14 to \$15 million yet to complete everything that is needed). Continued concern on high fees. Delinquent accounts continuing to hold at approx. 9% of the total properties. Based on what we are seeing, we would expect 5% or greater turned over to the county. We have had 2 foreclosures by the county (both in Selma Twp). This leaves LMSA with uncollected fees. Property owners with the force main across their property have filed a lawsuit.
Zoning	Wetherell: Time for townships to appoint a representative. Will discuss under New Business.
Road Advisory Rpt	Road Commission was busy assisting Gaylord, rebuilding their roads after their big storm. They are now back and getting started working in Wexford County with building shoulders up and chip & seals.

New Business

1. Aaron Sogge (Cherry Grove EMS Director): Aaron and township board members discussed contract, benefits of continued partnership, free training for our firefighters, free community risk reduction programs. **Motion to approve contract with Cherry Grove Township for \$40,000 per year for 3 years – Boyd/Wetherell – B,W,K,P – all yes.**

2. Blue Tech upgrade to PA system for hall: **Motion to accept bid from Blue Tech of \$2,200 for upgrade to PA system – Boyd/Kuyers – B,K,W,P – all yes**

3. Zoning Reps: Perrin offered to continue being rep. **Motion for Perrin to continue as our representative for Zoning Board of Appeals – Perrin/Wetherell – all yes.**

4. Wage Resolution: Boyd read aloud **Salary Resolution 02-2025**. No changes to wages. Kuyers mentioned he has checked on wages of similar sized townships, and Selma's wages are inline. **Motion to pass Salary Resolution 02-2025 – Boyd/Kuyers – B,K,W,P – all yes**
