

Call to Order	Trustee Wetherell called meeting to order at 7:00 PM.

Assessor’s Report	Assessor not present. Hettich reported no land splits.

Approval of Minutes	<b>Motion to approve Minutes of May 13, 2025 as presented – Perrin/Kuyers – all yes</b>
Payment of Bills	Check #20360-20411, AP=\$11,071.47, Payroll=\$21,338.41, Auto Pay (Fire Truck/Hall Pymts)=\$3,602.95, Total=\$36,012.83. <b>Motion to approve payment of bills as presented – Perrin/Kuyers – P,K,H,W – all yes</b>
Treasurer’s Report	Treasurer’s report was received. Accounts are balanced. Re-issued 2 small checks (\$4.16 & \$6). If not cashed this time, the amounts will be donated to the fire dept. Invested \$115,000 into MI Class from 220 Road Fund. Will be collecting taxes at the Twp Hall from 10am-3pm on July 2, 9, 16, 23, 30; August 6, 13, 20, 27; and September 3, 10, 15, or by appointment. Taxes are NOT collected at the Treasurer’s home. Received letters from Supervisor Boyd indicating we got the distribution checks for the blight on the Leaf property (\$141.67). The County is saying they sent us the checks, but we have not yet received them. Will call about this. Taxes will be coming out July 1.
Maintenance	All properties have been mowed & weed whacked. PFAs results from Cyclopure for the Twp hall: 2.8. The State standard is 4.0. Discussion on signs and review of estimates. Decided not to get a new sign for the hall building at this time, instead just a double sided 4’x8’ sign from Crazy Kat Signs to be put on posts. Sign to say “Selma Township” and list board meeting & fire meeting dates/times. <b>Motion to pay Crazy Kat Signs for a sign for no more than \$2,000 – Hettich/Wetherell – H,W,K,P – all yes.</b> Discussed estimates for sealcoating. Fire Chief to confirm 2 coats. Sealcoating discussion tabled until annual meeting. Discussed asphalt estimates. Chief to check on referrals and get correct price on 1 of the estimates. Asphalt discussion tabled until annual meeting. Put all new signs up at parks. The trailer that we have been receiving complaints on, located on West side of road, Lk Mitchell, is up for auction.
Fire Dept Report	
Fire Runs to Date	Assisted Cherry Grove with residential structure fire; 2 car PIA 34 Rd & M-115; 2 car PIA 34 Rd & M-115; Greenhouse fire 13 <sup>th</sup> St Market; Assisted Cherry Grove EMS with patient & transport.
Trucks	Good working order. Engine needs air horn service. Nelson’s will repair.
Station	2 probation firefighters did not pass Fire 1&2; scheduled to retake test in September. Need tools: Nozzles (\$1,186 & \$1,286), ice rescue suit (\$895); 1 D-handle 6” New York hook w/chisel (\$169); wildland rakes \$248; SCBA’s (up to \$6,000 worth). <b>Motion to approve purchases for fire department as stated for up to \$10,000 plus shipping costs – Hettich/Kuyers – H,K,W,P – all yes.</b> Fire Chief will also purchase headlamps.
Cemetery/Parks/Liquor	Cemetery has been mowed; will mow again Friday & empty trash cans. Parks have been landscaped. Will rent skid steer to grade parking lots (a lot of gravel displaced from plowing). Will get black dirt at Pleasant Lake. Discussed rocks for barrier at cemetery & parks parking; tabled until board does inspection. Kuyers asked about putting trash cans at parks. It was discussed that in the past, too many people have used the trash cans for their household trash and it becomes a big problem. Liquor inspection is complete.
Short Term Rentals	Inspected 1; 2 more coming up.
Sewer Report	Kuyers: Nothing new to report for funding. Contract 1: Adding 1 grinder pumpstation (not started yet). Issue with wooden bollards that were installed; do not meet County Rd Comm requirements. Once these items are completed, final walkthrough will take place. Contract 2: Adding generator pads to stations to be worked on this year. Construction on lift stations is still scheduled to restart in July. Contract 3: 9 grinder pumpstations have not yet been started. Contractor stated they will start within the next couple of weeks. Continued concern on high fees. The number of delinquent accounts has reduced a little. Based on what we are seeing, we still expect 5% or greater to be turned over to the County. Sewer fees starting with the new year

in July will be reduced to \$154 per month. This is a reduction from last year, as part of the fee was an amount collected to have matching funds available if a requested federal grant is approved. Nothing new to report on the lawsuit regarding the force main.

**New Business**

1. 115/34 Rd Street Light: Perrin stated streetlight was called on in May. Recently called Consumers and was told it has been reported and is tagged, but couldn't say when it will be fixed.
